**** Did You Know****

In 1904 San Diego lodge held the first Flag Day ceremony. In 1907 Grand Lodge encouraged all lodges to do so. In 1911 the observance was made mandatory making the Elks the first in US to officially do so. President Wilson in 1916 proclaimed National Observance of Flag Day and in August 1949 President Truman (himself an Elk) proclaimed June 14th for the yearly national observance. The Elks take pride that Florida Elk Joseph Vrtel designed the current 50 star United States Flag.
